# Infiniti Design De-contest 2012



**De-contest** LIVING EVERYWHERE Infiniti design contest

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## **INTRODUCTION:**

The **INFINITI DESIGN DE-CONTEST** competition is entitled "LIVING EVERYWHERE" and is aimed at young designers born after 01/01/1972.

To enter the competition, designers must present projects for the following product groups for use in a domestic setting:

- CHAIRS
- STOOLS
- TABLES
- OTHER HOME FURNISHING ACCESSORIES

Ideally these projects should represent **ONE OF THE FIVE CONTINENTS** taking inspiration from how they have been portrayed in some **INTERNATIONALLY RENOWNED FILMS**.

Taking as a starting point the idea that the history of design should be seen as a process of evolution which draws inspiration from all the different parts and arts of the world, designers are asked to design *innovative furnishings which represent their* **CONTINENT OF ORIGIN**, *interpreting this continent according to how it is portrayed in the world of cinema*. In other words, when creating their design, <u>designers must use a film which is set entirely in the continent where they live as their inspiration</u>. This means, for example, that an Indian designer can chose to reference only one of the four films set in Asia, and not the others. The suggestion of these films should not be considered as a restriction, but as a possible aid to help to interpret the continent in question (e.g. to evoke –through a chair, stool, table or other furnishing- the America that is revealed in "New York, New York": a world of jazz and nightclubs, where everyone can have their fifteen minutes of fame before glamour meets harsh reality).

The winning project in each category will be decided by an expert jury.

- The 3 CATEGORIES are:

- ASIA AND OCEANIA
- THE AMERICAS

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<u>a project dedicated to the designer's native continent, using how this continent is</u> <u>portrayed in a certain film as their inspiration.</u>

### **ENTRY:**

ENTRY TO THE COMPETITION IS FREE. THE COMPETITION IS OPEN TO ALL YOUNG DESIGNERS BORN AFTER 01/01/1972 OF ANY NATIONALITY. In entering the competition, participants agree to the rules in this call for proposals and waive rights to the reproduction and publication of projects submitted for competition purposes.

# PRIZE:

AN EXPERT PANEL OF JUDGES WILL SELECT THE BEST PROJECTS SUBMITTED AND WILL DETERMINE A WINNING PROJECT IN EACH CATEGORY.

The contest, in accordance with Italian Presidential Decree no.430 of 26 October 2001, is solely a call for industrial proposals and thus should not be considered a prize competition. This means that all costs for the construction and industrial production of the winning projects will be the liability of the Omp Group company, in recognition of individual merit. The objects created by the winning designers will be included in the Infiniti Design catalogue and sales rights will be agreed between the company and the designer with a formal professional contract.

As in all contests, the jury's decision will be final.

## SIZE AND FORMAT REQUIREMENTS:

**FOR EACH PROJECT 3 (THREE) RENDERINGS MUST BE SUBMITTED** in 3500x2500 pixel format, bearing the designer's name and the project title as they are written on the enrolment form. The project renderings must be uploaded to the dedicated section on the www. infinitidesign.it website by the closing date of the competition.

### **COPYRIGHT:**

The intellectual property rights and copyright of projects submitted remain the property of individual designers. In participating in this call for proposals, designers agree that if their design wins they waive all rights to the publication of, and any other publicity regarding, their product and name for the purposes of the competition.

### **PRESENTATION OF WINNING PRODUCTS:**

Winning products will be presented during the Salone del Mobile di Milano (The Milan Furniture Fair) held from 17th to 22nd April 2012.
