

Regulations of the International Design Competition entitled “NEW VISION OF THE LOFT”

§1. GENERAL PROVISIONS AND MAIN DEFINITIONS

1. The Co-organizers of the International Design Competition entitled “**NEW VISION OF THE LOFT**” are:
 1. FAKRO Sp. z o.o based in Nowy Sącz, 144a Węgierska Street, Nowy Sącz, Poland, registered in the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register, kept by the District Court for Cracow – Centre, XII Commercial Division of the National Court Register under the following number: KRS 0000110248 represented by Mr Ryszard Florek, CEO.
 2. A10 Magazine for European Architecture, published by Sun Architecture, part of the Boom uitgevers Amsterdam, represented by Ms Martien de Vletter, hereinafter referred to as Organiser,
2. The Organizers are represented by the Organizing Committee consisting of:
 1. Sławomir Gawlik – Managing Marketing Director - FAKRO Sp. z o.o
 2. Katarzyna Dobosz-Jojczyk - PR Specialist – FAKRO Sp. z o.o
 3. Sabina Sujew – Export Manager - FAKRO Sp. z o.o.
 4. Małgorzata Respekta-Paszkiewicz – Architect Liaison Specialist
3. The Organizing Committee is obliged to:
 1. organize the competition properly
 2. verify the correctness of participants' applications
 3. inform participants about acceptance of their applications
 4. send applications to the JURY (members of the JURY and their tasks are defined in §2 of the Regulations)
 5. inform the winners about the awards
 6. act in case of complaints
4. Every natural person holding a University Degree in Architecture or European equivalent or working as an architect can become a participant of the Competition.
5. Employees of the Organises are not allowed to take part in the Competition.
6. The Competition will be held between 3 October 2011 and 16 April 2012 (considering 16 April 2012 as the date marking the end of the competition and awarding the winners, i.e. transfer made by the Organiser).
7. Projects will be evaluated by the Jury on 27 March 2012 and the results will be announced on our website at www.fakro.com by 3 April 2012
8. Application for the Competition and visualization projects can be submitted within a period from 3 November 2011 to 20 March 2012 (the date until which the application form must reach the Organizer). The Organizer is not liable for any errors that may occur in connection with the electronic transmission errors or system, which are not caused by the fault of the Organiser.
9. The awards in the Competition are as follows:
 - I place 5000 Euro
 - II place 3000 Euro
 - III place 2000 Euro
10. FAKRO Sp. z o.o. funds entirely the award mentioned above. The award will granted according to the provisions stipulated in the Natural-Person Income Tax Act. The Organizer will fund an additional money prize to cover the tax liabilities referring to presenting the award. Additional money prize will be send by the Organizer to cover the costs of the income tax on prizes and awards.

§2. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

1. In order to take part in the competition the participant has to:
 1. fill in the application form provided at www.fakro.com (all spaces in the form are mandatory and must be filled in)
 2. send the participant's resume along with a photograph and consent for the processing of personal data for the purposes of the Competition and free use of the submitted visualizations in informational and advertising materials.
 3. prepare and send in visualizations of architectural concepts of the loft with FAKRO products including mandatory min. 2 windows FDY-V U3 Duet Proszy and 1 window FGH-V P2 Gallery. The format of projects is min. A4, resolution 300 DPI, size min. 50MB, max. 100MB
 4. required language: English or Polish
2. On the website of the Competition www.fakro.com, there is an address of the data exchange server to which any architectural visualization should be sent. After sending the file with visualization, there will be generated a link which should be copied and sent along with completed application form and resume to fdc@fakro.pl.
3. Each person who fulfills the conditions stipulated in the regulations and sends correctly completed documentation by the mentioned deadline will be informed about this fact by the Organizing Committee by e-mail within 3 working days from the date of sending the application form.
4. FAKRO Sp. z o.o., as the co-organizer of the Competition reserve the right to use visualizations sent for the competition in their informational and advertising materials free of charge at any time.
5. The Organizing Committee shall have the right to reject the application for participation in the Competition if any information given in the application form proves to be false or the visualization work do not meet the rules of the competition.
6. Materials sent for the Competition, mentioned in §2 section 1 will not be sent back by the Organizing Committee.
7. On behalf of the Organizer, the Organizing Committee will pass correctly sent applications to the JURY.
8. The names of the members of the JURY will be published on www.fakro.com
9. The JURY's assignment is to evaluate and choose three winning projects, selected from all correctly submitted for the Competition and award I, II and III place.

§3. SUPERVISION OVER THE COURSE OF THE COMPETITION

1. The Organizing Committee supervises the correct course of the Competition and granting the awards.
2. The Committee in case of any doubts associated with the Competition shall take conclusive decisions.

§4. PROCEDURE IN CASE OF COMPLAINTS

1. Any complaints concerning the Competition may be sent during the whole time of the Competition.
2. Any written complaints should be sent to the address of the Organizing Committee that is: FAKRO Sp z o. o. 144a Wegierska Street, 33-300 Nowy Sącz, Poland, with an annotation "NEW VISION OF THE LOFT". The closing date for sending the complaints is 10 April 2012. After that date no complaints will be accepted.
3. Complaints should include the exact description, the reason for the complaint should be

- stated clearly and accompanied with full data of a participant who lodges the complaint.
4. Complaints will be verified within 14 days from the date they reached the indicated address. The participant will be informed about the binding Committee's decision with a registered letter within 14 days from the date of examination of the complaint.

§5. FINAL RESOLUTIONS

1. The Organizer reserves the right to introduce changes into that Regulations during the time of the Competition, under the condition that those changes will not worsen the conditions of participation. All changes will come into force from the time of their publication at www.fakro.com.
2. Personal data of the Competition's participants which have been collected for the purposes of organizing the competition will be used by the Organizer only for purposes concerning organization and carrying out the Competition. FAKRO Sp z o.o. based in Nowy Sącz, 144a Węgierska Street, is responsible for managing the personal data of participants. Personal data of participants will be processed following the rules defined in the Personal Data Protection Act (DZ.U. Z 2002 r. Nr 101, poz. 926 z późn zm.¹). Participants have the right to view their data and the possibility to change or remove it.
3. The Regulations provided herein are the only ones defining the conditions of the Competition.

5. The Organizer shall not take any responsibility for the actions of third persons which can make it impossible for the participant to take part in the competition.

8. Binding interpretation of the Regulations is made by the Organiser.
